Candlelight Service - date to be announced.

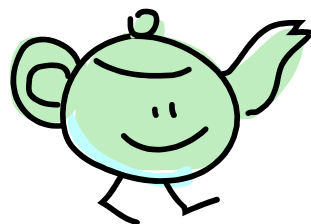
Tuesday 25th CHRISTMAS DAY - 10.30am, short service at Melksham United Church together with the Baptist folk, as usual.
